IMPORTANT - MEASLES INFORMATION

Please note this important information regarding measles circulating around New Zealand at this time.

- Measles is highly contagious and serious about one in three people may need hospital care.
- Measles is circulating and is very contagious. There is now measles in Northland, Auckland, Manawatu, Nelson and Wellington, and we expect further cases across New Zealand.
- Watch out for symptoms fever, cough, runny nose, sore eyes, and a blotchy rash:

Measles - Health New Zealand

- Anyone with measles symptoms must stay at home and should seek urgent advice by ringing their doctor or Healthline on 0800 611 116.
- Anyone who is closely exposed to a measles case must stay at home. Heath New Zealand will provide
 individuals with advice on a case-by-case basis (including when they can leave quarantine at home).
- Health New Zealand is actively working with the schools that currently have measles cases.
- People are considered immune to measles after having two doses of a measles vaccine from 12 months or older, or if you have had measles before. For more information on measles immunity visit: <u>Measles Immunity</u> -Health New Zealand

INFINITY PLUS ONE VISIT TO POMPALLIER ...

On Monday 20 October, Subash Chandar K, the founder of Infinity Plus One, visited our college. Infinity Plus One is a mathematics website that is free for all students to access. Subash has developed tutorial videos for senior mathematics students at Level 1, 2 and 3 NCEA.

Pompallier Catholic College students access these videos regularly, because Subash explains clearly and in detail how to complete algebraic and calculus NCEA examples.

Subash's talks on Monday were about "Balancing the Equation" and "Solving for X". However, his talks were not about Mathematics, they were about: making and achieving short-term and long-term goals, balancing productive and leisure time, reflection on the use of time, patterns and happiness chemicals.

The overwhelming consensus of Subash's visit was that it was exciting, interesting and helpful.

Subash signed calculators, gave out Infinity Plus One key tags and posed for selfies with students. Daniel Hugo received an Infinity Plus One hoodie from Subash, for being the most active Pompallier Catholic College student on the Infinity Plus One website. Daniel was also instrumental in us booking Subash's visit. Thank you, Daniel.

Thank you to our Art teacher, Ms Jensen, for organising this event.

























