2026 BUS INFORMATION

Pompallier Catholic College buses will begin running from Tuesday 27 January 2026 on all of our school routes. However, the students who use other schools' buses to connect to ours should check with their bus company to confirm their start date.

There may be changes to bus services early in the new year to allow for changes in our school population. We do our best to accommodate as many of our students as possible, within the guidelines set by the Ministry of Education. All changes will be notified as soon as possible.

All services are under review by the Ministry of Education, and will be confirmed at the beginning of 2026. Once finalised, details will be available on the transport page of our college website.

A reminder that eligibility is dependent on where a student lives, available public services in the area, and loading limits.

Student ID's also double as your bus pass, and these will be issued in the first few weeks of the new year. Until then, no pass is required.


