Pompallier Catholic College School Rule:

Prohibition of Unauthorised Commercial Activity and Trading

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Pompallier Catholic College school rule is to maintain a safe, fair, and focused learning environment, to ensure food safety standards are met, and to prevent the commercial exploitation of the school environment for private profit.

2. Unauthorised Trading and Sales

- **Prohibition:** Students are strictly prohibited from selling, offering for sale, or trading food, beverages, or any other goods to other students or staff on school grounds or during school-sanctioned events for **personal gain or private profit**. This does not include teacher-led, curriculum-based enterprise projects such as Business Studies Market Days.
- **Scope:** This includes, but is not limited to, the resale of drinks, confectionery, homemade food items, clothing, or electronic goods.
- **Consequences:** Students who break this rule will be subject to normal school Pastoral processes, with various possible consequences depending upon the nature of the incident.

3. Authorised Fundraising

The School Board recognises the value of student-led service and legitimate fundraising.

- **Approval Process:** Any student or student group wishing to sell items for fundraising purposes must first obtain formal authorisation from the school.
- **Requirement:** A "**College Request to Fundraise**" form must be completed and submitted to the Deputy Principal Academics at least three weeks prior to the proposed start date.
